MYTH 1

FAMILIES HAVE TO PAY FOR HOSPICE CARE

Hospice care is covered by Medicare, Medicaid, and most private insurances.

MYTH 3

HOSPICE CARE MEANS I CAN'T SEE MY PHYSICIAN
